- Math – Solve this problem using pictures, numbers and/or words.

Describe the number of dinosaurs in two ways.
- Reading – Read a just right book for 20-30 minutes. Write down the title of the book you read and answer this question: Write a character trait for the main character (smart, funny, helpful, mean, etc.) Why did you choose this word? **YOUR RESPONSE MUST BE AT LEAST 5 SENTENCES.**
- Word Study – Write three rhyming words for words 1-5.

Tuesday

- Math – Solve this problem using pictures, numbers, and/or words.
Emmanuel put 38 stickers on his paper. How can you model 38? How can you write the number in two ways other than 38?
- Reading – Read a just right book for 20-30 minutes. Write down the title of the book you read and answer this question: Write a character trait for the main character (smart, funny, helpful, mean, etc.) Why did you choose this word? **YOUR RESPONSE MUST BE AT LEAST 5 SENTENCES.**
- Word Study – Write a story using words 6-10.

Wednesday

- Math – Solve this problem using pictures, numbers, and/or words.
Lee has a favorite number. The number has the digit 3 in the ones place and the digit 9 in the tens place. What is another way to write this number?

- Reading – Read a just right book for 20-30 minutes. Write down the title of the book you read and answer this question: What is the main character’s problem in the story? What advice would you offer to the character on how to solve his or her problem? **YOUR RESPONSE MUST BE AT LEAST 5 SENTENCES.**
- Word Study – Write a meaningful sentence for each word (11-15). (Your sentence should be complete enough to demonstrate that you understand the meaning of the word.)

Thursday

- Math – Solve this problem using pictures, numbers, and/or words.
Dan’s number has a digit greater than 5 in the ones place and a digit less than 5 in the tens place. What could be Dan’s number?
- Reading – Read a just right book for 20-30 minutes. Write down the title of the book you read and answer this question: What is the main character’s problem in the story? What advice would you offer to the character on how to solve his or her problem? **YOUR RESPONSE MUST BE AT LEAST 5 SENTENCES.**
- Study for spelling test

- Math – Solve this problem using pictures, numbers, and/or words.
I have 2 bags of 10 oranges. I also have 24 single oranges. How many oranges do I have?
- Reading – Read a just right book for 20-30 minutes. Write down the title of the book you read and answer this question: Make a text-to-self connection. Have you ever had an experience that is similar to one that the main character had? Explain. **YOUR RESPONSE MUST BE AT LEAST 5 SENTENCES.**
